Travel Days 1 - 2

DAY 1: USA –DUBROVNIK

- Depart on international flight to Dubrovnik.

DAY 2: DUBROVNIK (WD)

- Arrive in Dubrovnik
- Meet and greet your tour escort and depart by bus to your hotel.
- Check-in to the hotel.
- Lunch on your own.
- Welcome Dinner.
- Overnight in the Dubrovnik area.



Travel Day 3

DAY 3: DUBROVNIK (B, FD)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out of the hotel
- Depart for Dubrovnik.
- City tour of Dubrovnik including Stari Grad, the extraordinarily well-preserved old city regarded as one of the world's most exquisite walled cities.
- Free time and lunch on your own
- Acoustic rehearsal and sound check.
- **CONCERT I:** Possible venues include the Cathedral of the Assumption of the Virgin Mary, Rector's Palace, St. Blaise's Church, Sponza Palace, Franciscan Church and Monastery, and other venues. Possible collaboration with a local ensemble.
- Check in to the hotel.
- Dinner on your own.
- Overnight in Dubrovnik.



Travel Day 4

DAY 4: DUBROVNIK – SPLIT (B, D)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Early Check out of the hotel
- Depart for Split.
- Lunch on your own in Split
- City tour of Split, an active port that is home to the ancient Roman Palace of Diocletian. This UNESCO World Heritage Site is the greatest Roman ruin in Central Europe.
- Group Dinner
- Check into the hotel
- Overnight in Split region.



Travel Day 5

DAY 5: SPLIT – PLITVICE LAKES – LJUBLJANA (B)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Depart for Plitvice Lakes.
- Sightseeing tour of Plitvice Lakes National Park. You will tour the sixteen crystal-blue lakes, each on a different level, joining each other in a series of cascading waterfalls, surrounded by dense woods. Plitvice Lakes are a natural phenomenon of a rare and unique beauty.
- Continue on to Ljubljana
- Free time and lunch on your own.
- Walking tour of Ljubljana. The Ljubljanica River flows through the heart of town, with dozens of shops and restaurants on its promenaded embankments. The city's large market squares sprawl along the river's south bank, between the Plecnik-designed Triple Bridge and the Dragon Bridge, near the Cathedral of St. Nicholas (built in 1701).
- Dinner on your own
- Overnight in Ljubljana.



Travel Day 6

DAY 6: LJUBLJANA - BLEED - LJUBLJANA (B, L)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Depart for Bled.
- Bled is blessed with natural hot springs regarded as having healing powers, and has been a popular fresh-air retreat since the mid-19th century.
- Group lunch.
- **CONCERT II:** Possible concert in Ljubljana or Bled as part of their Summer Music Festival. Venues include the Franciscan Monastery's Church of Annunciation, St. Martin's Parish Church, Cathedral of St. Nicholas, and others. Possible collaboration with a local ensemble.
- Return to Ljubljana.
- Dinner on your own.
- Overnight in Ljubljana.



Travel Day 7

DAY 7: LJUBLJANA - ZAGREB (B)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out of the hotel.
- Drive to Zagreb.
- Lunch on your own.
- City tour including the Lower Town (Donji Grad) where you'll see many of the city's civic and historic monuments and Upper Town, with Zagreb's medieval landmarks, such as the neo-Gothic Cathedral of the Assumption and St. Mark's Church. Your walk ends at the Square of Ban Jelacic (Trg Bana Jelacic), the city's hub.
- Check-in to the hotel.
- Dinner on your own
- Overnight in Zagreb.



Travel Day 8

DAY 8: ZAGREB (B)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- **One (1) workshop/master class** with choral expert in Zagreb or elsewhere on the tour.
- Free time to explore on your own.
- Lunch on your own.
- Acoustic rehearsal and sound check.
- **CONCERT III:** Possible venues include St. Catherine's Church, St. Mark's Church, and other venues. Possible collaboration with a local ensemble.
- Farewell Dinner.
- Overnight in Zagreb.



Travel Day 9

DAY 9: ZAGREB – USA (B)

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out of the hotel
- Depart on international flight to the USA.
- Arrive in the USA.



Pricing

ESTIMATED PRICE: Per person estimates based on the minimum number of paying.

- **45-60 pax: \$4,105.00 per person**

LAND ONLY: **\$2,595.00 per person.**

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT: \$TBA per person to be confirmed after hotels are booked.

PRICING VALID: Pricing is valid for a maximum of thirty (30) days from the date of this offer. After thirty (30) days prices may change.

Inclusions

The following concert, artistic, press, promotion, travel, accommodations, meals and services are included in the price.

- Round trip airfare from Dallas to Dubrovnik with a return from Zagreb. While the net base fare is often guaranteed, the government and carrier-imposed passenger facility charges, security and custom charges, immigration charges, domestic and/or international taxes, federal excise taxes, fees, surcharges, levies, and any other charges are not guaranteed and are subject to increase. The Organization is responsible any increases in airfare costs.
- Seven (7) nights of twin or double room accommodations, including all taxes and service charges, at 3-star hotels, based on the final itinerary
- City taxes which are charged per night per person.
- Seven (7) breakfasts at the hotels
- One (1) welcome dinner
- One (1) farewell dinner
- Two (2) other meals, lunches or dinners, as per the final itinerary

Inclusions Continued

- One- Two (1-2) local English speaking tour managers from arrival to departure
 - Local English speaking tour guide(s) as needed
 - One- Two (1-2) motorcoaches and drivers as per the final itinerary
 - Sightseeing tours and entrance fees with substitutions as per the final itinerary
 - Tips to guides and drivers
 - Arrangements for three (3) concerts/exchanges/services, including:
 - Venue rental or as provided by presenters
 - Standard concert programs or as provided by the presenters
 - Concert promotions, including flyers and posters or as provided by presenters
 - All tour press and promotion will be arranged by Classical Movements
- *Venues subject to change based on budget, ensemble size, and other factors. Concerts are booked after we receive a signed contract.
- One (1) workshop/master class

Inclusions Continued

- Customized tour app to view your trip details including accommodations, transportation, activities, daily tour itinerary, travel guides, performance and cultural event details, trip journal, and other helpful travel tools, maps and more.
- One (1) free space for (20) paying tour participants sharing twin or double room accommodations including all taxes and service charges at 3 star tourist class hotels based on the final itinerary. The non-paying participants will remain responsible for all costs listed in exclusions, below. The Organization and the free spaces are responsible for any increases in airfare costs.
- Classical Movements fee

Exclusions

The following travel, accommodations, meals and services are **not** included in the price and must be paid separately in full by the Organization or individual members of the touring party.

- The Organization is responsible for any increases in airfare costs for all travelers including the free spaces.
- Increases in the contract price due to changes in the exchange rate.
- Checked baggage, carry-on baggage, and associated fees.
- Changes in flight schedule, delays or cancellations. Classical Movements will assist to provide alternatives and minimize any costs resulting from changes made by the scheduled airline; however, any costs (e.g. hotel, meals and transport) resulting from forced overnights or changes in the reserved flights are the responsibility of the Organization.
- Instrument rentals and transportation.
- Truck rentals, van rentals, trailers for the transportation of instruments and excessive baggage.
- Porterage at the airport and hotel. Porterage/luggage handling costs are not included in the contract price; however, if the Organization would like for Classical Movements to arrange for a porter or luggage handler at any time, the Organization will advise Classical Movements, and Classical Movements will add porterage costs to the contract price as requested.
- Personal items. Items of a personal nature such as: laundry and telephone calls are not included in the contract price.

Exclusions Continued

- Meals not included in final itinerary, including meals at airports and on flights.
- Airport and airline meals and snacks. If airlines do not offer complimentary meals, snacks, and/or beverages, the Organization is responsible for the cost of purchased meals, snacks, or beverages. These services along with payment options vary by airline. Classical Movements will advise the Organization after the airline is booked and again prior to departure date as the options are subject to change.
- Special meals/dietary restrictions. Classical Movements will try to accommodate requests for special dietary needs whenever possible; however, alternative options may not be available or may cost significantly more, resulting in a surcharge.
- Cost of obtaining a passport. The passport should be valid for at least six (6) months beyond the period of stay. Classical Movements is not responsible for ensuring that the travelers comply with the entry and exit requirements of each destination country and is not responsible for lost, stolen, or unattained passports.
- Cost of obtaining a visa, entry fees or exit fees. For further information concerning entry and exit requirements, travelers should contact the local embassy for each destination country. Foreign nationals are subject to different requirements than U.S. Citizens. The requirements and fees are subject to change. Classical Movements is not responsible for ensuring that Organization touring members comply with the entry and exit requirements of each destination country and is not responsible for lost, stolen, or unattained visas, entry fees or exit fees.

Exclusions Continued

- Cost of a work permit. If a work permit is required, the Organization will be responsible for the entirety of the fees.
- Water at rehearsals and concerts. Water is not included for rehearsals and concerts in the contract price; however, if the Organization would like for Classical Movements to arrange for water during the tour, the Organization must advise Classical Movements, and Classical Movements will add water expenses to the contract price as requested.
- Translation expenses. Translation expenses for the Organization and conductor resumes and other promotional materials (“Materials”) typically are \$300-400 USD, but Classical Movements cannot guarantee prices until it has received all Materials from the Organization. The Organization may provide all Materials in foreign languages as needed at its option, provided that all materials are grammatically sound and appropriate for publishing.
- Transportation of persons, baggage and instruments in the USA.
- Musicians or soloists for hire.
- Stage crew/hands for hire.

Exclusions Continued

- Performing rights fees, copyright fees, and/or royalties per each concert. Classical Movements will inform the Organization of any such fees when known.
- Expenses as a result of quarantine, travel delay en route to, from, or during your trip, trip interruption, airline reissue fees, missed flights due to extra screenings at the airport for COVID-19, medical expenses, screenings and tests for COVID-19, and other costs are not included.
- Classical Movements recommends each participant have a travel protection plan for the duration of the tour. Travel protection plans with and without trip cancellation coverage are widely available and should be chosen based on the ensemble's and each participant's specific travel needs. Classical Movements will send you more information.
- Insurance for instruments and other personal property that you take on tour is not included. Travel Protection Plans sometimes have limited coverage depending on the type of property and value.
